- Careers in pharmacy
 - Evolving role of pharmacists
 - Work in community settings, hospitals, and the pharmaceutical industry
 - Community pharmacy: fast-paced, very community-oriented; about 50% of pharmacists work in this setting
 - Chain community pharmacies
 - Can start your own independent pharmacy
 - Community pharmacies: highest retail business with highest retail margins
 - Competition is high among CVS, Walgreens, etc.
 - Rapid advances in technology opening novel avenues for practice
 - Hospital settings: about 25% of pharmacists
 - Ambulatory care: carefully monitor patients' medications
 - About 75% of pharmacists in a hospital setting take on specialist positions
 - Beauty of pharmacy: there's more to retail pharmacy
- Pharmacogenetics
 - Study of the relationship between variants in genes and drug response
